MISSIONARY REPORT APRIL 2018



DURING THE MONTH OF APRIL 2018, A SPECIAL MISSION TOOK PLACE IN CAMBODIA VIA THE «FRONTLINEMESSENGER» MINISTRY.

The Frontline Messenger team was on site along with several Adventist brothers and sisters from France, Belgium, Austria and Switzerland. Together we were able to carry out many activities in Cambodia from April 17 to 25.

Humanitarian and Social Support for the Poor

Approaching the local population to the best of our ability was done by first providing humanitarian support. We were able to provide food and water to the poorest populations that we had time to visit through more than 250 kg of rice distributed in bags of 8 kg per family, and by constructing wells.





Sharing the Gospel

Once this first step was accomplished, we were able to share with them several messages of hope by preaching to them the gospel of Jesus Christ; the presence of Christophe Michel of the ministry «The Sentinel of the Times» (La Sentinelle des Temps) allowed us to present in-depth subjects about Christ for this population still too ignorant of what the LORD wishes for their present and future life.

During this missionary excursion, we were also able to offer more than 500 books «Steps to Christ» in Khmer to the population we met, or sometimes just bumped into depending on thencircumstances, such as on the Ton LeSap Lake which is an hour and a half from Siem Reap and where many Khmer live in houses on stilts.



Kits for Children

Cambodia has a very young population, and many Khmer children do not have the opportunity to open up to foreign cultures because of their geographical isolation. Nevertheless, they learn to read and write, which allows them to get to know Christ, thanks to this book «Steps to Christ» in Khmer, that we have been able to offer them by the hundreds via kits which also include a notebook, a pencil and a sharpener. They are the future of this country and, therefore, must absolutely know Jesus Christ, who is The Way, The Truth, and The Life.







Support for Local Churches

We couldn't have forgotten our brothers and sisters in Christ, who are at times new converts to the Seventh-day Adventist message. It was once again a pure privilege for our team to offer the most valuable book on earth, and a first experience for most of the volunteers from Europe to see the critical lack of material available to Adventist members in this country. In the most remote places and churches, we have been able to provide more than a hundred members with Bibles and songbooks.



Calling to the Crowds

To close this mission, we had the opportunity, thanks to God, to offer a conference open to the public in a large village (Loviat) 30 km from Siem Reap. Thanks to the presence of Christophe Michel (The Sentinel of the Times), we were able to hold this event. He also preached many times throughout the mission with messages about the family and the interest that God has for this subject, as well as about Jesus Christ. Following this, a question and answer period with the audience took place. It was the opportunity for many exchanges about Jesus Christ and the Bible. Then the team of European volunteers was able to offer praise songs in French. We were also able to offer a meal to more than 200 people at the end of this conference, as well as the book «Steps to Christ».
